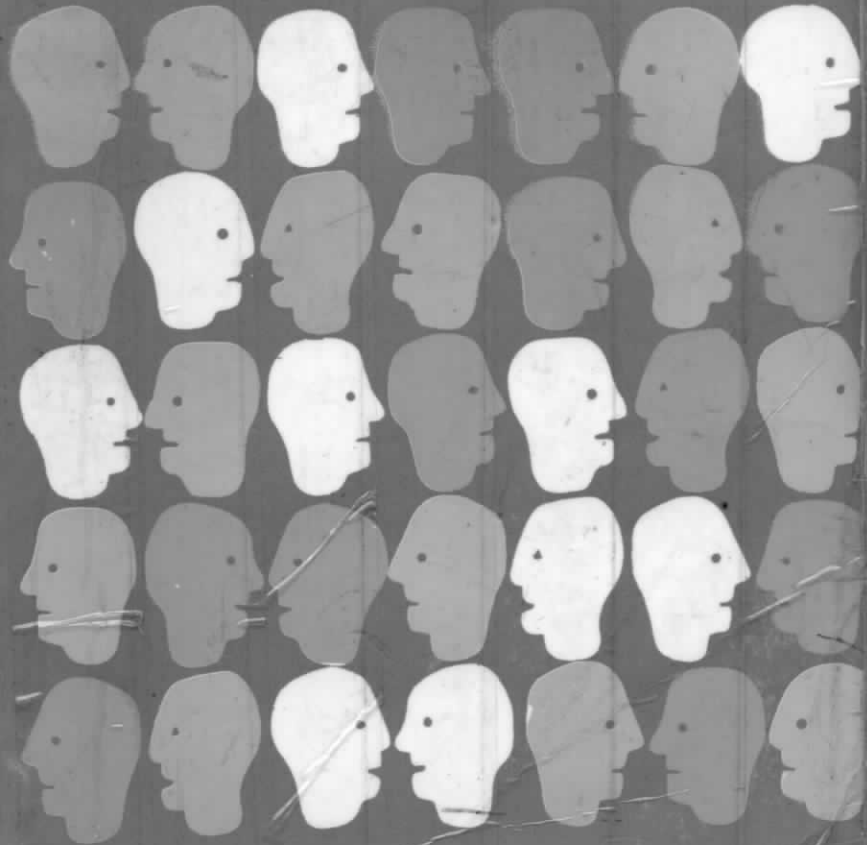


Colloquial English
